AirCheckTexas Repair and Replacement Program

HB2134 created the Low Income Repair Assistance, Retrofit and Accelerated Vehicle Retirement program in affected emission testing counties to assist low income vehicle owners in those counties. At the owner's discretion the program can either assist them with the emissions related repair costs or in retiring their vehicle if it is uneconomical to repair it. The program is administered by TCEQ through local government agencies based in the program area. Repair grants under this program can only be paid to repair facilities participating in the Texas Department of Public Safety's Recognized Emissions Repair Facility Program.

REPORT EMISSIONS REPAIRS ONLINE

Reporting emissions repairs is easy and convenient. Technicians can now report their own repairs real-time. Skip the hassles of keeping track of vehicle and repair information and report repairs as soon as you are done with the work.

- Use a mobile device or computer to submit your repair.
- Visit: **Vehicle Inspection Connection (VIC)**
- Login using your technician ID and password.
- Click the “Report emissions repairs” link
- Enter vehicle details and Submit



VEHICLE REPAIR FORM (VRF)

A motorist, who brings a vehicle in for emissions repairs, after failing an emissions test, should present a VEHICLE REPAIR FORM (VRF), VIE-7. If the motorist did not receive a VRF from the inspection station, please provide one to the motorist.

We have enclosed one copy as a sample and this form may be reproduced if additional copies are required. The VRF should be fully completed by the Recognized Emissions Repair Technician that made the repairs to the vehicle, and returned to the motorist after repairs have been completed.

The VRF must be completed upon return for re-inspection or if the customer is applying for a waiver; therefore, if your facility is performing the repairs, please complete the VRF and return it to the customer. If the customer chooses to take their vehicle to a non-recognized repair facility or do the repairs themselves, advise the customer they will be responsible for completing the form.

It is important to note emissions repairs reported to the department are identified by facility and technician. These reported repairs, as well as a vehicle's ability to pass an emissions test subsequent to these repairs, will be used to determine a facility's repair effectiveness.

Therefore, it is important to keep current the department's records regarding technicians associated with your facility.
