





Day 1 Weather Hazards

- No Weather Threats Expected

Hazardous Weather



Showers and thunderstorms are expected again today with the best chances across the southern half of the region. Locally heavy rainfall and flash flooding will be the primary hazards, but occasional lightning will also be possible.

Afternoon highs today will be mainly in the 70s.



The Flash Flood Watch has been extended in time, and now is in effect until 7 PM Saturday. An additional 1 to 3 inches of rainfall are expected and, with already saturated soils and swollen rivers and creeks, additional heavy rainfall can cause flash flooding. The greatest concern for today will be over the eastern half of South Texas, spreading west tonight and Saturday. Remember, DO




