




WindSpd(Kts) & WindDir For Thu Jun 23 2016 5PM EDT











Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 335 (+1) fires and 77,976 (+1) acres destroyed this year. There are 38 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 2 (no change) counties with an average over 400.

- FD - 23 fires for 24 acres
