




WindSpd(Kts) & WindDir For Mon Jun 27 2016 5PM EDT



A persistent upper level disturbance will keep rain chances over primarily the western portions of West Central Texas today. Rainfall will be heavy at times and may cause localized flooding. Highs today will be in the lower 90s.







# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 337 (no change) fires and 78,142 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 37 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 13 (+6) counties with an average over 400.
