



Wind Speeds







Severe Weather Outlook Wednesday, July 06, 2016






It will be hot again today with temperatures ranging from near 100 in the Davis and Guadalupe Mountains, to the low 110s in the Trans Pecos and Rio Grande valley.




Very hot weather will continue today across west central Texas. Another Heat Advisory in effect, for the northeastern Big Country through this evening and into Thursday.

Hazardous Weather




Expect a hot and humid Wednesday across nearly all of North and Central TX. A Heat Advisory is in effect for areas along and northeast of a Killeen to Mineral Wells to Breckenridge line. Across the advisory area, heat index values will range between 105 to 108 degrees. Remain hydrated and NEVER leave children or pets in hot cars!




Hot and humid conditions will continue today with maximum heat indices ranging between 103 to 109 F. Highest values will be over the coastal counties.

Hazardous Weather



Temperatures will continue to be a few degrees above normal this afternoon with mostly sunny skies. With humidity, it will feel like it is 105-110 degrees with a few locations possibly exceeding 110, so stay well-hydrated and take several breaks if you are outdoors today. Small Craft Advisories are in effect for the Laguna Madre and offshore Gulf Waters.



Above normal high temperatures will continue across South Central Texas today, ranging from the mid 90s in the Hill Country to near 106 along the Rio Grande. A humid air mass will persist with above normal heat indices this afternoon into early evening. Maximum heat indices of 108 to 110 are expected along and east of I-35 where a Heat Advisory is in effect from 1 PM to 7 PM. Elsewhere, maximum heat indices of 98 to 108 are expected. South to southeast winds of 10 to 20 miles per hour will prevail with gusts up to 30 miles per hour possible.




Burn Bans and KBDI INDEX
