


Severe Weather Outlook Tuesday, July 19, 2016





Hazardous Weather



Isolated, late day showers and thunderstorms are possible along and east of a line from Sherman, to Corsicana, to Mexia and Hearne. Lightning strikes are expected to be the main hazard. Highs will warm into the middle-upper 90s with afternoon heat index values ranging between 99 and 105 degrees.



A Heat Advisory has been extended through Wednesday for all of Southwest Arkansas, North Louisiana, and portions of extreme Eastern Texas. Temperatures will climb into the mid and upper 90s each day, which when combined with the humidity, will result in heat indices ranging from 105-108 degrees.






