

Tropical Weather Awareness



For the North Atlantic, Caribbean Sea and the Gulf of Mexico: A tropical wave accompanied by a low pressure system is producing an area of showers and thunderstorms about 400 miles southeast of the Cabo Verde Islands. Some development of this disturbance is possible during the next few days while it moves westward or west-northwestward at 10 to 15 mph. However, environmental conditions are expected to become less conducive for development early next week when the system is over the central tropical Atlantic Ocean. Formation chance through 48 hours, low, 30 percent . Formation chance through 5 days, medium, 40 percent





Wind Speeds







Severe Weather Outlook Thursday, July 28, 2016



Hazardous Weather



A thunderstorm complex is expected to develop this afternoon and this evening across the Central Plains States. This thunderstorm complex is expected to move south and east tonight into much of the eastern portions of the Texas and Oklahoma Panhandles. This complex of thunderstorms will be capable of producing thunderstorm wind gusts in excess of 60 mph. The threat for hail will be low, however hail up to quarter size or even half dollar size cannot be completely ruled out.




Scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected today across Central Texas, the far northern Hill Country, and east of I-35 and I-37. Isolated showers and thunderstorms are expected elsewhere. A few isolated storms could produce heavy rainfall of 1 to 3 inches. On average, rainfall amounts will be 1/4-1/2 inch with any storms. High temperatures will generally be in the low to mid 90s.


Fire Danger Forecast
