






- No Weather Threats Expected

*Threat levels are based on FEMA Region 6 criteria. State or local threat level criteria may differ.







Burn Bans and KBDI INDEX



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 469 (+12) fires and 98,535 (+1,024) acres destroyed this year. There are 115 (+2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 231 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
