





There is a chance for showers and storms across North and Central Texas today, Labor Day. Severe weather is not expected but stronger storms may produce gusty winds, and lightning will be a threat with all storms. Outflow winds from storms can travel several miles away from storms and affect locations in their paths. A washout of outdoor activities is not expected but if thunderstorms occur in your area, take shelter indoors until 30 minutes after the storm has passed.



Near normal highs in the mid 80s to low 90s are expected today, with storm chances mainly near the higher terrain and across the south. Locally heavy rainfall and lightning are the primary threats with storms. Windy conditions expected for the Permian Basin and Lower Trans Pecos this afternoon. Sustained speeds near 25 mph gusting to 40 mph at times.







Reports 525 (no change) fires and 110,838 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 64 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 82 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
