
## Five-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

X indicates current disturbance location; shading indicates potential formation area.






## Wind Speeds




# Hazardous Weather



Residual low level moisture will remain in place across the Borderland Monday, giving the area scattered thunderstorms. A few storms could produce gusty winds up to 40 mph, along with brief heavy rainfall and pea size hail. Temperatures will run a few degrees above normal.

Reports 526 (no change) fires and 110,838 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 60 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 96 (-7) counties with an average over 400.
