




WindSpd(Kts) & WindDir For Thu Sep 29 2016 5PM EDT







Reports 546 (+3) fires and 113,336 (+90) acres destroyed this year. There are 53 (-1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 92 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
