





Severe Weather Outlook Saturday, October 01, 2016









Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 551 (+4) fires and 113,434 (+82) acres destroyed this year. There are 53 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 100 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
