

# Hazardous Weather




Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms will continue this morning across the northern half of West Central Texas, as an upper level disturbance moves across the area. Decreasing clouds and warmer temperatures are expected this afternoon.




It will be mostly cloudy this morning with a chance of showers and thunderstorms. Heavy rain and cloud to ground lightning will accompany some of these storms.

# Hazardous Weather



A Dense Fog Advisory is in effect for the highlighted areas in grey through 10am. Visibilities of 1/4 to 1/2 mile or less will be likely or are being observed. Fog will dissipate through the morning hours.



Warm to hot Today with isolated showers and thunderstorms over the Coastal Bend/Victoria Crossroads and over the adjacent Coastal Waters. Highs will range from the mid/upper 80s East to the lower/mid 90s West. There is a moderate risk for rip currents along Gulf-facing Beaches.






