





Hazardous Weather



Hold on to your hats...it will turn very windy tonight for southern New Mexico and west Texas. Scattered to numerous showers and thunderstorms are expected across the area. A wind advisory is also in effect for southern Dona Ana, west El Paso and northern Hudspeth counties from midnight to 9 pm Thursday, for strong east- northeast winds 25-35 mph with gusts to 45 mph or higher possible. A cold front will surge through from east-northeast roughly between 9 pm and midnight over our area. Differences in pressure across the frontal boundary, will result in the strong winds expected. Secure any loose belongings. **IMPACTS:** Local downburst wind gusts to 40 mph or more and hail Strong winds - Poor vehicle handling. This will be the immediate impact for motorists traveling on north-south oriented routes. ..particularly the I-10/25 corridor between El Paso and Las Cruces.



Thunderstorms will be likely, especially along and east of the Pecos, along a cold front that moved into the region Wednesday night. Any storms that develop will be accompanied by frequent lightning, heavy rainfall, small hail, and brief gusty winds. The main concerns over the next 24 hours will be heavy downpours resulting in localized flash flooding.



- High Rip Current Risk along Gulf facing beaches


Issued at 6:05 AM - November 3, 2016

Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms will be possible across South Texas today. A Coastal Flood Advisory is in effect this afternoon and tonight for Kleberg and Nueces Counties due to minor coastal flooding expected at the time of high tide. There continues to be a high rip current risk along Gulf-facing beaches today.







Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 649 (+4) fires and 114,810 (+10) acres destroyed this year. There are 68 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 144 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
