


Severe Weather Outlook Sunday, November 06, 2016



Hazardous Weather



Scattered to numerous showers and thunderstorms will move through the Permian basin this morning, then move out of the area this afternoon. Gusty winds, locally heavy rainfall and frequent lightning strikes will accompany the stronger storms.



Rain will be increasing from west to east today with up to an inch of rain possible in locations west of Interstate 35/35W. The rain will continue moving east this evening and into the overnight hours. Locally heavy rainfall could result in localized flooding. It will be cloudy and cool with highs in the mid 60s to mid 70s.







Reports 650 (no change) fires and 114,815 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 67 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 122 (-3) counties with an average over 400.
