



# Hazardous Weather




Patchy fog will be possible through mid-morning across portions of the area. Drivers be prepared for sudden changes in visibility.



# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 656 (no change) fires and 114,825 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 63 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 81 (+1) counties with an average over 400.
