



# Hazardous Weather



We will see strong winds across the area on Monday as colder air moves into the region. Strongest winds will be along and just east of area mountains. Temperatures will be 10 degrees lower than Sunday's high temps. Skies will be partly cloudy.



Strong to Severe Thunderstorms will become very likely today as an upper level storm system moves into our region from the west. Damaging Wind Gusts...Isolated Tornadoes, Large Hail and moderate to heavy rainfall will all be possible before these storms exit our region this evening.



# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 697 (no change) fires and 115,095 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 61 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 93 (+1) counties with an average over 400.
