News conference scheduled for Friday, 11 a.m.

Law enforcement agencies participating in the Texas Ranger Recon operation will speak at **11 a.m. Friday in Weslaco** about the shooting and drug interdiction efforts along the border.

The news conference will be held at the **new** DPS office in Weslaco at 2525 N. International. (If you're coming from McAllen, go east on U.S. 83. Get off at the FM 1015 exit. When you exit, turn left at the bypass and head north to Mile 9/Sugarcane Road. Turn left at the second light (Mile 9), and the DPS building is 1 block north on the right-hand side.)

Update to this morning's news release:

- Two law enforcement officers sustained minor injuries not related to gunfire during the incident.
- The incident occurred in Hidalgo County, shortly after 6 a.m.
- A multi-agency investigation is currently underway and U.S. Customs and Border Protection, the FBI, the Texas Department of Public Safety and the Government of Mexico are working closely to determine the complete circumstances of the shooting.
