For Drug Analysis

Collect either a blood sample or urine sample for drug analysis. **Blood is preferred for driving cases.**

A urine sample should be supported by a DRE Exam.

Samples collected for both alcohol and drug analysis should be submitted to the appropriate Texas DPS Laboratory Service Area. The sample will be forwarded to the Texas DPS Laboratory in Austin for drug analysis when alcohol analysis is complete if the BAC is less than 0.100 g/100mL (urine: g/67mL). Samples collected for **Drug Toxicology Analysis Only** must be sent to the Texas DPS Laboratory in Austin.

All alcohol concentration requests for sexual assault cases should be sent to the Texas DPS Laboratory in Austin.

The Texas DPS Laboratory in Austin will perform toxicology drug analysis of blood if that is the only specimen submitted for a sexual assault investigation, otherwise only urine will be analyzed.
