

Board Resolutions Adopted January 27, 2009

The following resolutions were adopted by the board in order to clarify the board's policies, pending adoption of related rules to be proposed at the next public meeting.

Resolution relating to Rule 35.311 and the exemption for installation of locksets in certain circumstances.

The following proposal for modification of Rule 35.311 may be construed as an expression of the board's position with respect to the exemption from regulation for those who install locksets in certain circumstances.

An owner or employee of a retail establishment open to the general public may perform work on a mechanical security device of the general public within the confines of the establishment or new construction or renovation of property of which installation of mechanical security devices are only a small portion of the project and does not require the re-keying of any existing mechanical security devices, providing that the person does not use the term "locksmith" or any similar term that would lead a reasonable consumer to believe that the person is a ~~registered~~ licensed locksmith. The work on the mechanical security device must be limited to servicing only products sold by the establishment or duplication keys.

Resolution relating to ASSIST Training Requirement Proposal

The attached document may be construed as an expression of the board's policy relating to training requirements, pending adoption of a related rule at the next board meeting.
