

## REQUIREMENTS

- A- Two amber reflectors, one on each side near front.
- B– One amber reflector on each side, centrally located on body of trailer.
- C- Two red reflectors, one on each side near the rear.
- D- Two red stop lamps on the rear, one on each side.
- E- Two red reflectors on the rear, one on each side.
- F- Electric turn signal lamps on rear.

- $G-\ \mbox{Two}$  side marker lights, one on each side centrally located.
- H- Hazard lamps
- I- Clearance lamps (front and rear).
- J- Side marker lights (front and rear).
- L- White license plate light
- T- Tail lamps
