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# Mission of OEC's Regional Coordination Program

To enhance OEC's collaboration with Federal, State, regional, local, and tribal emergency responders and provide State, local, and tribal support to regions regarding OEC service offerings, national policy, and the goals of the National Emergency Communications Plan (NECP).



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# Regional Coordinator Roles

- Serves as the OEC representative in the region and provides OEC leadership with regular updates on emergency communications challenges and successes.
- Develops and cultivates working relationships with Federal, State/Local/Tribal representatives in the region.
- Supports efforts for regional State/Local/Tribal planning and preparation to enhance Federal, regional and State/Local/Tribal emergency communication processes and systems to operate during routine and significant incidents.



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
# Regional Coordinator Roles

- Coordinates support of and promotes adoption of national emergency communication policies and plans (to include the NECP goals and objectives) by State/Local/Tribal emergency communication stakeholders.
- Provides RECCWG coordination support and serve as OEC RECCWG representative.
- Supports coordination of Technical Assistance to the region.
- Coordinates and supports demonstration projects, regional and/or cross-border planning/projects, and technology initiatives in the region.

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# OEC, FEMA, and NCS

- OEC RCs collaborate and coordinate with State/Local/Tribal to improve their emergency communications capabilities and support NCS and FEMA in the Federal response to disasters.
- FEMA DEC RECCs provide Federal capabilities to support tactical response during a disaster.
- NCS Communications Liaisons provide Federal response and recovery of commercial communications infrastructure during a disaster.
