

State of Texas Mandatory Terms of Self-Quarantine

Pursuant to the Texas Governor's Executive Order GA-11, dated March 26, 2020, you are ordered to comply with the following mandatory terms:

- 1) Proceed directly from the airport to your designated quarantine location, which is the residence, hotel, or other lodging identified by you on the Form that is being collected by a DPS Trooper.
- 2) Remain in your designated quarantine location for a period of 14 days or the duration of your stay in Texas, whichever is shorter.
- 3) Do not visit any public spaces or leave the designated quarantine location except to seek medical care or to depart from Texas.
- 4) Do not allow visitors into or out of your designated quarantine location, other than a health department employee, physician, or healthcare provider.
- 5) DPS Special Agents may conduct unannounced visits to your designated quarantine location to confirm your physical presence.

Under Texas Government Code § 418.173, failure to comply with these mandatory terms is a criminal offense punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000, confinement in jail for up to 180 days, or both.
