Pursuant to the Texas Governor's Executive Order GA-12, dated March 29, 2020, persons entering the State of Texas through roadways from Louisiana, or from any other state that may be designated, must self-quarantine for 14 days or the duration of presence in Texas, whichever is shorter, and must provide the following information:

Mandatory terms can be found at www.dps.texas.gov/COVIDtravel. **Under Texas Government Code § 418.173, failure to comply is a criminal offense punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000, confinement in jail for up to 180 days, or both.**
