## Sexual Assault Evidence - Late Submission Notification Form

LAB-216 Rev.00 (04/2022) p.1 Issued by: SQM

**Purpose**: HB 2462 was effective September 1, 2021 and requires law enforcement agencies that fail to submit evidence of a sexual assault to an accredited lab within the period required by law (30 days) to provide to DPS written documentation of the failure including a detailed explanation for the failure.

The documentation must be submitted on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date on which the agency discovered the evidence was not submitted.
