Sponsors and RiderCoaches,

Texas offers three versions of the MSF Basic RiderCourse being conducted throughout the state. The original BRC and 3WBRC which utilizes training aids and the BRC 2013 which utilizes a power point presentation; range exercises remain the same. Regardless of the dates and times of a Sponsor's schedule, the intended sequence (classroom before range) should be followed as suggested in the RiderCoach Guide on page 21. BRC, 3WBRC and BRC 2013 scheduling guidelines are noted below.

Classroom:

BRC and 3WBRC:

Classroom Units I through III must be conducted before any range activities occur.

BRC 2013:

Classroom sections are to be presented in chronological order with the exception of Section 16, Range Preparation, which should be used immediately before beginning the range work. Also, there is no particular break point for splitting up the classroom content, although a natural break in the content occurs after Section 6, Risk and Riding. Complete Sections 1-6 before beginning the range work.

Range:

- BRC and BRC2013 range exercises must be divided between at least two days; preferably between exercises 9 and 10, however it is acceptable for the division to occur between other exercises. For the 3WBRC, the preference is between exercises 5 and 6 as stated on the range cards.
- Daily instruction shall not exceed eight hours, however, if additional breaks and/or extended breaks are required, this will not count towards instructional time.
- The BRC may not be advertised or scheduled for less than 15 hours of instruction; 5 hours of classroom and 10 hours of range.
