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Sponsors and RiderCoaches,

Texas is transitioning to MSF's BRCu curriculum over the course of the next year and a half. Below is some general information along with the policies and guidelines when offering and conducting BRCu curriculum.

The BRCu (also referred to as e3x5x10) consists of the following components:

- 3 hours - Level I Classroom (Rider Handbook content) is now an online Basic *eCourse*
- 5 hours - Level II Classroom (behavioral content)
- 10 hours - Level I and II range exercises

Texas approved schedules for the BRCu:

- Pre-course - prior to regular formal instruction
 - Completion of the MSF Basic *eCourse*
- Day 1 (schedule can begin with class or range; content from slides 2-4 must be covered before range)
 - Level I range - completion of the Level I riding exercises 1-8
 - Level II classroom - some formal classroom activities
- Day 2 (schedule can begin with class or range)
 - Level II range - completion of the Level II riding exercises 9-14 and skill test
 - Level II classroom continued - any remaining formal classroom activities

Note: Level II Formal Classroom initial slides (2-4) are used before going to the range; consists of waivers, introductions, self-assessment chart and pre-riding quiz. Content from slides #2-4 may be conducted on the range as long as a Rider Handbook is provided to each student at that time to conduct the Controls Quiz activity.

Knowledge Test and Skill Evaluation:

- No retests allowed; no exceptions. If student fails either the knowledge test or skill evaluation, the entire course must be taken again to include a new *eCourse* certificate within 30 days of new course.
 - Knowledge Test
 - To be conducted before slide #5; this must be done in a classroom setting
 - Skill Evaluation
 - To be conducted after riding exercise 14

Additional policies and guidelines:

General:

- The BRC may not be advertised or scheduled for less than 15 hours of instruction; 5 hours of classroom and 10 hours of range.
- Daily instruction shall not exceed eight hours, however, if additional breaks and/or extended breaks are required, this will not count towards instructional time.
- Once a Sponsor's range is transitioned to the BRCu curriculum, both the BRCu and BRC may be offered until all their RiderCoaches have successfully completed a TRCP. Once all Sponsors have transitioned, only the BRC2u will be available in Texas.

Classroom:


- Classroom activities must be divided between at least two days; there is no curriculum recommendation where the division should occur.

Range:

- Range exercises must be divided between at least two days; curriculum recommendation is between exercises 8 and 9, however it is acceptable for the division to occur between other exercises.
