Waiver of Motorcycle Knowledge Test

The Texas Department of Public Safety Driver License Division has amended the Texas Administrative Rule 15.55 waiving the requirement for motorcycle applicants to take a motorcycle knowledge test.

Beginning January 12, 2015, any customer who has a MSB-8 (*or a completion card from an approved state or military motorcycle safety training program*) as proof of completion of a department approved motorcycle operator training course, and applies for one of the 3 licenses below, DOES NOT have to take the motorcycle knowledge test.

- **Unrestricted Class M;**
- **Class M restricted to three-wheeled motorcycles; or**
- **Class M restricted to a motor-driven cycle (250 cc's or less)**

The Texas Administrative Rule 15.55 continues to require a motorcycle knowledge test for any applicant applying for Moped license.

The motorcycle skills test CANNOT be waived for any applicant under 18 years of age and is not required for those applying for a Moped license.
