Option 1: For existing MSF Rider Enrollment System (RES) users, or sponsors interested in using RES for on-line enrollment, class scheduling, and class management; the Basic eCourse is fully integrated into RES. Basic eCourse integration features include:

- Upon enrollment in a publically available Basic *RiderCourse*, students will automatically be enrolled in the Basic eCourse
- Online PCI compliant payment collection features with direct deposit into sponsors bank account
- Robust management reporting features

Option 2: For sponsors who maintain their own enrollment system and need to provide students access to the Basic eCourse, MSF will create a sponsor account for you in RES. With this account sponsors can issue Basic eCourse coupons to students. This will provide the following functionality:

- Ability for sponsors to download blocks of coupons and issue them to students as they enroll in classes
- Coupons can be provided to students with the enrollment e-mail they receive through your enrollment system so it will be up to the sponsor to decide how to implement this functionality into their enrollment system
- Each coupon is good for one student and a single use of the Basic eCourse
- Sponsors have the ability to lookup individual student completion status through their RES account
- Sponsors can manage coupons and track coupon assignments and redemptions through their RES account

Option 2 pricing:

- \$4.99 for each student registration or \$3.99 for sponsors using the MSF Quality Assurance System

Option 3: For sponsors who maintain their own Learning Management System (LMS) and wish to consume the Basic eCourse content but not share Personally Identifiable Information (PII), MSF offers delivery of the Basic eCourse to your LMS through an anonymous SCORM compliant platform called SCORM.com. This allows you to:

- Access Basic eCourse content through your LMS without sharing student information
- As the sponsor you assume the role of customer service and support, and tracking of student completion data
- As the sponsor you assume responsibility for integrating your LMS into your enrollment system

Option 3 Pricing:

- \$2,500 one-time integration fee. This involves an MSF consultant working with your designated IT staff in a customized engagement to implement the Basic eCourse into your LMS. Duration typically takes around two weeks depending on the complexity of the project
- \$4.99 for each student account created, or \$3.99 for sponsors using the MSF Quality Assurance System - billed directly to the sponsor quarterly

BRCU TEXAS APPROVED SCHEDULE GUIDELINES:

Completion of the MSF Basic *eCourse*
prior to regular formal instruction

Day 1

Schedule can begin with class or range; content from slides 2-4 must be covered before range

- Level I range - completion of the Level I riding exercises 1-8
- Level II classroom - some formal classroom activities

Day 2

Schedule can begin with class or range

- Level II range - completion of the Level II riding exercises 9-14 and skill test

- Level II classroom continued - any remaining formal classroom activities

NOTE: LEVEL II FORMAL CLASSROOM INITIAL SLIDES (2-4) ARE USED BEFORE GOING TO THE RANGE (CONSISTS OF WAIVERS, INTRODUCTIONS, SELF-ASSESSMENT CHART, PRE-RIDING QUIZ) AND THE FIFTH SLIDE (ACTIVITY-2) STARTS THE CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES FOR LEVEL II CLASSROOM AFTER LEVEL I RANGE IS COMPLETED.

MSF REQUIREMENTS:

- TEACH AT LEAST 4 COMPLETE BRCU COURSES IN 2 YEARS
- SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE AN ACTIVITY IN THE RETSORG PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CENTER'S RECERTIFICATION CENTER

ADDITIONAL TEXAS REQUIREMENTS:

- TEACH AT LEAST 2 COMPLETE COURSES IN EACH ADDITIONAL CERTIFIED CURRICULUM TO MAINTAIN TEXAS APPROVAL FOR EACH CURRICULUM
- ADULT CPR CERTIFICATION
- FIRST AID CERTIFICATION
- TEXAS RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OPTIONS

TEXAS RECERTIFICATION REQUIREMENT FOR RIDERCOACHES

NOT ABLE TO ATTEND IN-PERSON PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT COURSE:

- COMPLETE 25 QUESTION ASSIGNMENT RELATED TO ADULT LEARNING AND MOTOR SKILL PRINCIPLES
- MUST BE REQUESTED THROUGH TRAINING OFFICER AT LEAST 60 DAYS PRIOR TO EXPIRATION
- MUST BE SUBMITTED WITHIN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO EXPIRATION

FBI RAP

FOR THOSE WHO SUBMITTED FINGERPRINTS PRIOR TO JUNE 2015, YOUR WAIVER DID NOT INCLUDE AUTHORIZATION TO ALLOW FBI TO SUBMIT REPORTS AFTER PRINTS (RAP) TO DPS.

CPR/FIRST AID

REQUIRED FOR ALL INSTRUCTORS REGARDLESS OF MEDICAL PROFESSION

- INITIALLY EXEMPTED THOSE IN THE MEDICAL PROFESSION, BUT AFTER SOME RESEARCH HAVE FOUND THERE IS NO REQUIREMENT TO ATTEND REGULAR CPR/FA TRAINING TO MAINTAIN MEDICAL DEGREE/CERTIFICATE.
- ALL RIDERCOACHES NEED TO SHOW PROOF OF CPR/FA PRIOR TO TRCP.
