The meeting was called to order by Chairman McHugh. Proper notice had been posted. Chairman McHugh announced that the agenda items posted for today's meeting other than the discharge appeal hearing of DPS employee Granver Tolliver, Jr., had been taken care of at the June 29, 2005 Public Safety Commission meeting.

- I. **Discharge appeal hearing of DPS employee Granver Tolliver, Jr.** Granver Tolliver, Jr., nor anyone on his behalf was present. Phillip Adkins, Office of General Counsel, advised that DPS was ready to proceed with the hearing. Mary Ann Courter advised that Mr. Tolliver had received notice of the hearing and, pursuant to the Commission's policies, is deemed to have withdrawn his appeal since he did not appear. A motion was made by Commissioner Cascos, seconded by Commissioner Angelo and unanimously passed affirming the Director's discharge of Granver Tolliver, Jr. (see attached Order).
