Course Descriptions:

<u>Group A Offenses: Crimes Against Persons -</u> This class is for participants to gain a greater understanding of Crimes Against Persons whose victims are always individuals along with which data elements are mandatory when reporting these offenses.

<u>Group A Offenses: Crimes Against Property –</u> Class is for participants to gain a greater understanding of Crimes Against Property where the object of the offense is to obtain money, property, or some other benefit, along with which data elements are mandatory when reporting these offenses, including types of victims required.

Molly Jane's Law and ViCAP – This presentation will help you understand the basics of House Bill 3106, Molly Jane's Law, and the Texas requirements for law enforcement agencies on reporting incidents that apply to Molly Jane's Law.

<u>NIBRS Errors and Warnings –</u> This in-depth presentation highlights NIBRS errors, warnings, where to locate errors in the DPS system, and how to correct them.

Texas Specific or "T" Errors

This course will introduce and inform law enforcement agencies about the Texas Specific Errors and Warnings that they face in their Uniform Crime Reporting.
