

CARGO THEFT

What is Cargo Theft?

The criminal taking of any cargo that constitutes, in whole or in part, a commercial shipment of freight moving in commerce. Any product that is in transfer between the manufacturer and the seller in the supply chain is cargo.

Cargo Theft is **NOT** a separate crime.

Porch pirating is **NOT** Cargo Theft as the items are no longer commercial shipments since they are not in the supply chain.
