## Program Overview

- The tracking system will be a web-based system that can be accessed from anywhere with an internet connection.
- Survivors will be able to track the status and location of their evidence through a unique tracking number.
- Medical facilities, Law Enforcement, and Lab users will enter milestones as the evidence proceeds through the collection, analysis, investigation and retention process.
- DPS will work with the vendor to develop and provide training for user agencies.
- The system will be able to generate a variety of data driven reports to provide critical data to stakeholders.
