\*\* For 2014, the Rape definition has been redefined by the FBI in the Uniform Crime Reporting program as:

*“Penetration, no matter how slight, of the vagina or anus with any body part or object, or oral penetration by a sex organ of another person, without the consent of the victim.”*

This redefinition will cause a significant increase in the number of Rapes to be reported in 2014. Statistics reported in this crime category include assaults to commit rape; however, statutory rape (rape against a female under the age of consent) is excluded.
