## 2017 Crime In Texas - Executive

According to data compiled by the Department of Public Safety's Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) program, the overall major crime rate (the number of crimes per 100,000 population) in Texas for 2017 decreased 6.6% compared to 2016. The violent crime rate increased 0.4%: murder decreased by 5.8%; rape rate increased by 5.8%; robbery decreased by 5%; and aggravated assault increased by 2%. The overall property crime rate decreased by 7.7%, burglary decreased by 11.6%; larceny-theft decreased by 7.2%. Motor vehicle theft decreased by 3.5%. While the overall state index by volume decreased 5% compared to 2016, violent crime by volume increased by 2.1%.

The total number of juvenile arrests in 2017 decreased 7.1% from 2016, and adult arrests increased 0.1%.

The number of assaults on police officers in 2017 showed a 4.1% decrease from 2016. Seven law enforcement officers were reported killed feloniously in the line of duty, while seven died in duty-related accidents in 2017.

In 2017, Texas law enforcement agencies reported 190 incidents of hate crimes involving 229 victims and 209 offenders and 194 unique offenses. This marks an incident increase of 6.7% over 2016.

Law enforcement agencies reported 195,315 family violence incidents involving 212,307 victims and 207,231 offenders in 2017—an incident decrease of 0.6% in family violence occurrences compared to the year before.

Sexual assault data showed 18,112 sexual assault incidents involving 18,750 victims and 18,774 offenders resulting in an incident decrease of 1.3% from 2016.

### **STATISTICAL ANALYSIS OF CRIME**

#### ***The UCR Program***

In an effort to produce reliable crime statistics for law enforcement administration, scholars, researchers, members of the media, and the public at large seeking information on crime in Texas, the TXDPS UCR program collects crime data from local law enforcement agencies. The UCR program utilizes two different reporting methodologies: Summary reporting (SRS) and the National Incident Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The Summary Reporting System collects data on ten index crimes. By contrast, NIBRS collects a total of 52 offenses. Summary data (and Summary data derived from NIBRS reporting agencies) is used in a statistical

summary tool referred to as the Crime Index. Although arson is an index crime in that the number of reported offenses is collected, arson is not included in the Crime Index.

"We are pleased to see an annual trend continuing in Texas, where the overall index crime rate decreased in 2017. However, it remains concerning that at the same time, Texas experienced a second consecutive year with an increase in the rate and number of violent crimes," said DPS Director Steve McCraw. "We continue to see a nexus in Texas between criminal gangs, and the violent crimes of sex trafficking, murder, robbery, and assault as well as illicit drug trafficking and theft. If we are to make a significant impact and reduction into the state's violent crime, we believe a focus on the identification, interdiction, and prosecution of gangs in Texas is essential. The Texas Anti-Gang centers established across the state as part of Governor Abbott's initiative will play an important role in this effort. We will continue to work daily with our local, state, and federal partners to proactively combat these criminal elements and to bolster the safety and security of all Texas communities."

#### ***Index Crime Rate***

The crime rate reported by UCR is defined as the number of crimes committed per 100,000 population. This mechanism allows comparisons between periods of time to be made without being affected by population swings. For 2017, the Texas Crime Rate was 2,975 crimes per 100,000 population, a 6.6% decrease from 2016. The crime rate is based on the total Texas UCR reporting agency populations of 28,304,596.

#### ***Index Crime Volume***

The total number of Index Crimes reported for 2017 was 842,055. This volume of crime represents a decrease of 5% when compared to 2016.

#### ***Participation***

The Texas UCR program, though voluntary, experiences a high rate of participation with a total of 1,079 law enforcement agencies either directly reporting UCR data to the Department or being covered-by their county Sheriff. At the close of 2017, there were 153 NIBRS agencies approved and reporting. The FBI provides yearly population totals for UCR participating agencies (based on current Census data estimations.)
