Multi-phased Approach using SERI grants:

Phase 1 – Connect 4 Major Regional Systems plus 3 conventional sites

Multiple Vendors, Multiple system types

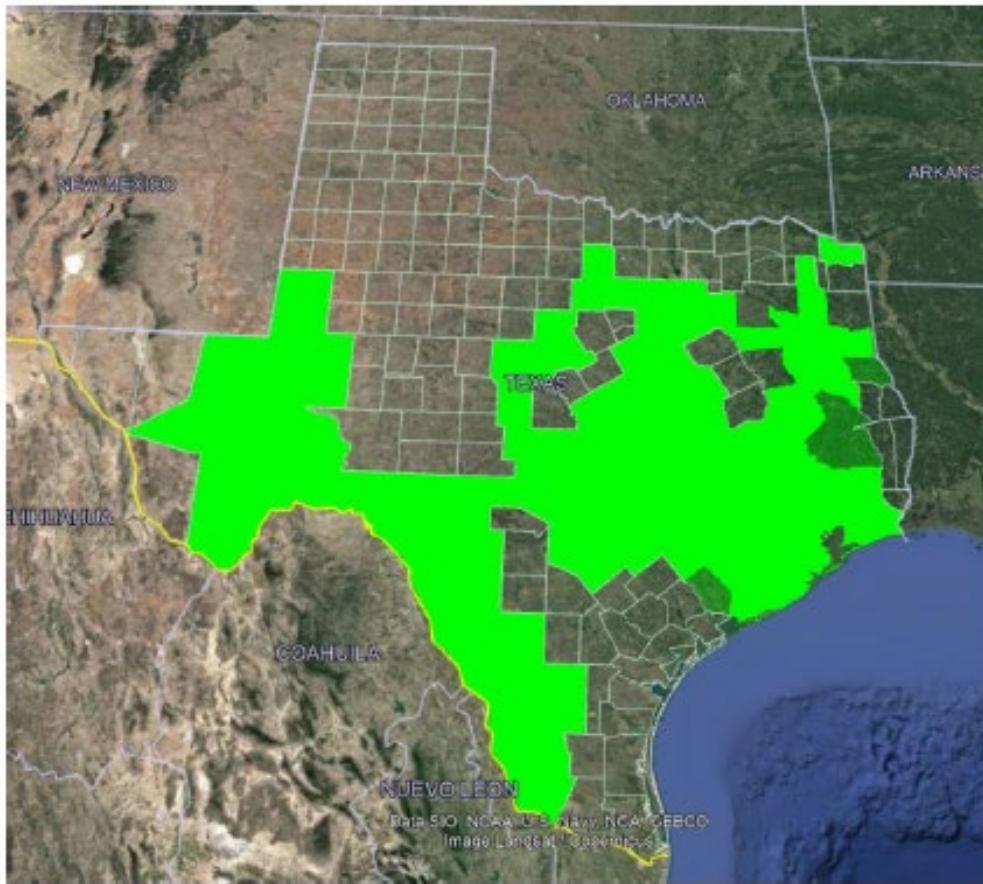
10 Statewide Interoperability Talkpaths

TIRIS – Phase 3

The SWIC office has applied for the FY25 SERI grant

Requested \$1.5M in funding to expand coverage

6/5/24 – Received notification of conditional approval for full amount requested

11/4/24 – Received notification that funding has been awarded

- Adds three trunked systems (Southeast Texas, Lower Rio Grande Valley, San Antonio/Bexar County)
- Adds seven additional conventional systems – We are looking for volunteers!
- Relocate the two DPS equipment to other areas of the state

TIRIS – Phase 4

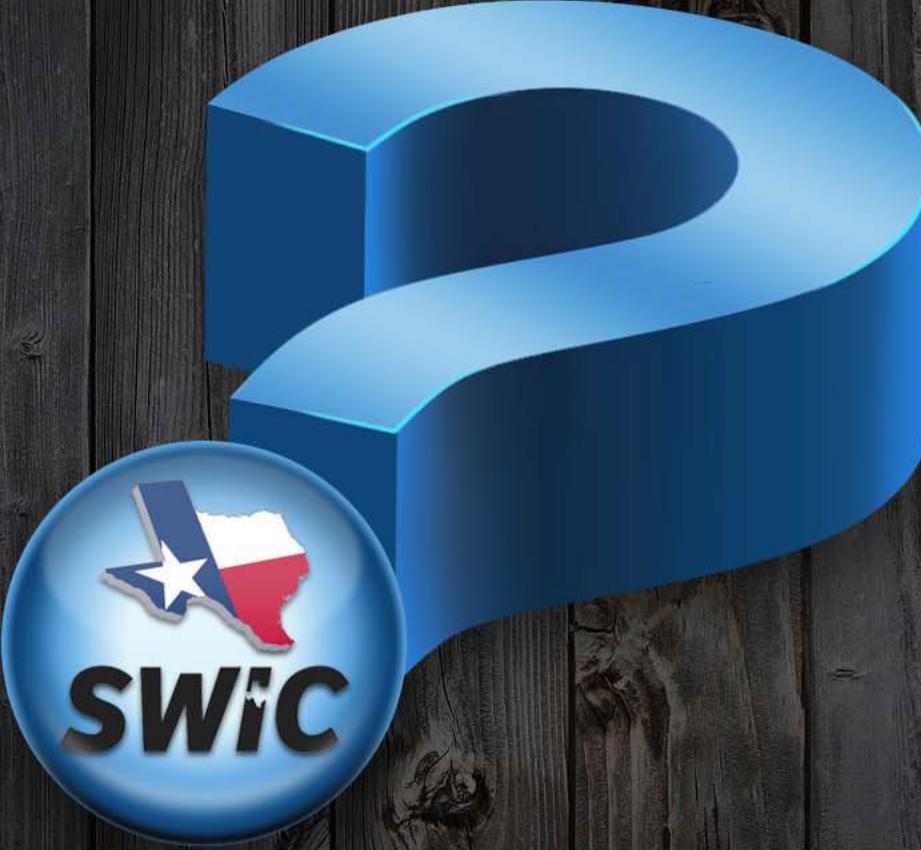
We are currently seeking input for Phase 4

- Should we continue to grow TIRIS and add more agencies or....
- Add more capacity/features of TIRIS
- Add more than 10 talkpaths?
- Work toward obtaining seamless roaming?

Texas has approximately 60 separate P25 Trunked Systems in operation or being built

- In order to continue with the System of Systems approach we recommend smaller radio systems consider joining or combining with a larger regional system connected to TIRIS
- Could save money by eliminating ISSI Fees (SWIC Goal is have the State fund this connection)
- Get the facts on ISSI
